

Part-A (Human Resource), Part-B (Physical Infrastructure & Other Facilities/Amenities), Part-C(AICTE Mandate) of the University proforma for inspections w.e.f. the session 2019-20

Action taken by the College on the conditions imposed by the previous Inspection Committee for grant of extension in provisional affiliation /additional course/increase in intake:-

The Institute complies the conditions laid by university for affiliation (all the administrative and Technical) both from Univ. and AICTE. Provisional affiliation granted for the year 2023-24. AICTE- issued EOA for 2024-25 for three courses as proposed/applied for affiliation. On laboratory front the Institute has to improve the computer lab facility as per scheme and syllabus prescribed by university. The Inst. has to get placed in its permanent infrastructure which takes time. The resources of Govt. Polytechnics are hence shared.

#### Observations/Recommendations:-

Observations: SET- shall have to develop its own library facility for its UG students separately. Book bank facility has to be created. In JNSOC/Journal/Subscribe has to be updated. Workshop/Drawing facilities are sharing with Govt polytechnic. As all the 3- courses are CSE background, computer labs shall have to updated with latest configuration and LAN facilities. OCA/OS may be encouraged. Particular/course prescribed licensed s/w may have to be obtained/procured. Faculty positions may have to filled up to improve discipline use Faculty cadre ratio.

Recommendation: Provisional Affiliation may be allowed B.Tech. CSE (AI+ML, Cyber Security) and Robotics & Automation for 2024-25.
